IMMUNIZATION HOURS EXTENDED

ORLANDO - The Orange County Health Department's Immunization clinic will be open during extended hours through the end of December 2011. Clients may check in as late as 6:30pm during the week and as late as 3:30pm on weekends.

Clinic hours are being extended for the following reasons:

- To provide an opportunity for students to come in early to be immunized for school. Students scheduled to enter kindergarten and 7th grade in August of 2012 are highly encouraged to take advantage of the extended clinic hours as the demand for vaccination services is high during the months of July, August and September. Adult clients may also get immunizations during the extended clinic hours.
- To improve ease of access to immunization services particularly for clients who are unable to come in for immunization services during normal business hours due to work and school commitments.
- To improve immunization rates in the community, especially for flu vaccination.
