Health and Safety Provider Pointers

An important part of the new health and safety rule for child care providers offering the School Readiness Program requires specific training for staff who work with children. All providers and staff must be in compliance with pre-service training by Mar. 31, 2017, or within 90 days of employment if they were hired less than 90 days before Mar. 31.

There are two training options. One is through DCF and the other through Early Learning Florida.
