

# Safety Precautions for the Classroom Environment Infants



### **Infant Room Arrangement**

## According to the CDC, it is highly recommended:

Phase 1: Separate the room for more than 8 infants. Each side of the room must have its own changing table, supplies, sink and toys. Remove the soft, plush toys that are difficult to frequently sanitize. You will still want to include space for infants to crawl, play, and walk.

Phase 2: Continue the phase 1 recommendations until all childcare centers have been cleared to return to normal business practices.







# **General Sanitizing Guidelines**



#### **STORE**

Soiled clothing or reusable cloth diapers in a sealed container for laundering outside of facility. 2

#### **ROTATE**

toys so they can be cleaned and sanitized after each use.



#### **SEPARATE**

Use a separate blanket to hold each baby and an individual blanket on the floor.



#### DISTANCE

When holding a baby, avoid getting too close to his/ her face.

# **Infant Checklist:**

Completed	In-Progress	Not Started	
			Follow safe diapering procedures/ bag soiled cloth diapers
			Have materials nearby to safely store soiled clothing
			Establish safe hand washing stations, washing hands freq.
			Arrange floor space so that infants can play away from others
			Rotate toys for proper cleaning after each use
			Reduce number of toys available for play to support rotation
			Establish a set bin for toys that need sanitizing out of reach
			Remove soft, plush toys that are difficult to sanitize
