Pre School Room Arrangement

According to the CDC, it is highly recommended:

Phase 1: Remove sensory and water tables, all soft toys, dolls and dramatic play clothing from the classroom. Turning shelves to face the wall and using tape on the floor to define spaces is also recommended. Have children always practice social distancing by remaining at least 6 feet apart. Permit one child in a center at a time.

Phase 2: Continue the phase 1 recommendations until all preschools have been cleared to return to normal business practices.
