

Safety Precautions for The Classroom Environment

Toddlers

Toddler Room Arrangement According to the CDC, it is highly recommended:

Phase 1

Potty Training and Diapering Areas:

- Follow safe diapering procedures/bag soiled cloth diapers
- Have materials nearby to safely store soiled clothing (DO NOT RINSE ON PREMISES)
- Sanitize toilets, door handles, etc. after each use or more frequently
- Refrain from group toileting
- Establish safe hand washing stations, where everyone can wash hands more frequently

Toys and Shelves:

- Arrange shelves in a way that allows for individual play and plenty of space
- Rotate toys for proper cleaning after each use
- Reduce number of toys available for play to support rotation
- Establish a set bin for toys that need sanitizing and keep out of reach
- Remove soft, plush toys that are difficult to sanitize

Divide rooms according to CDC group size guidelines and keep the same children with the same teacher as much as possible, staggering use of common or shared areas.

* Phase 2 Continue or begin phase 1 recommendation until all preschools have been cleared to return to normal business practices.
