Large Group Recommendations

RATIO: 1:5 Max Group: 10

- ❑ Children and teachers need to say in the same class and group every day.
- ❑ (SHALL NOT CHANGE FROM ONE GROUP TO ANOTHER)
- ❑ If more than one group of children is cared for at one facility, each group shall be in a separate room and not mix or interact with each other.
- ❑ Sanitize play areas between children transitioning to a new play area. (ie when playing in Centers A, C, E, be sanitizing centers B, D, and F.)

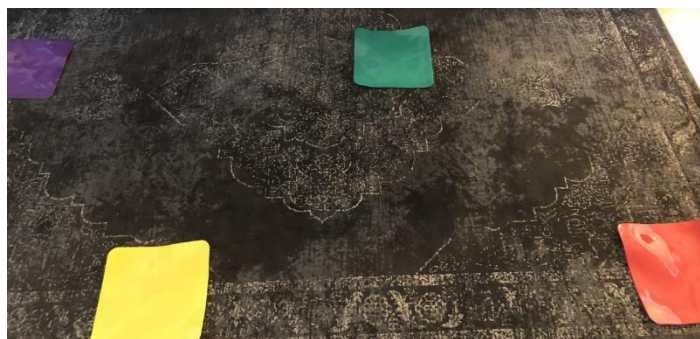
