Orange County Government has received \$243.2 million in Federal CARES Act funding. The County's [Small Business Grant Program](#) will provide \$10,000 in grant money to small businesses located in Orange County to help offset lost revenue due to COVID-19, and the [Individual and Family Assistance Program](#) for residents will provide a one-time payment of \$1,000 per household to bridge financial gaps for overdue rent, mortgage, medical or an eligible utility expense. **NOTE: This is for for-profit businesses only.**
