The Early Learning Coalition of Orange County (ELCOC) seeks the assistance of a qualified consultant to assist with health and safety consultation services to early childhood child care owners, directors, and family child care home providers in our community.

We assume the consultancy will occur between February 10, 2022 and June 30, 2022. Options to continue the consultancy to refine and expand the engagement may extend through June 30, 2023 based on ELCOC need and funding availability.

The specific assistance desired is:

- Provide early childhood owners, directors, and family child care home providers with a two-hour session at individual program facilities, focused on optimal implementation of health and safety standards specific to early childhood best practices.
- Develop and provide a session focused on health and safety best practices for the 2022 Early Childhood Business Conference. This conference may be offered in person or virtual.
- Identifiable metrics to capture and report health and safety services and common issues, concerns, successes, and relevant needs to further inform ELCOC early childhood business supports.

Applicants familiar with working with early childhood programs and our community's diverse business community are especially encouraged to apply.
