Unallowable expenses: This is not an all-inclusive list of unallowable items. Subrecipients are expected to contact the Early Learning Coalition of Orange County with questions regarding allowable cost. All items must align with the grant funding purpose.

- Software subscriptions that extend beyond June 30, 2025
